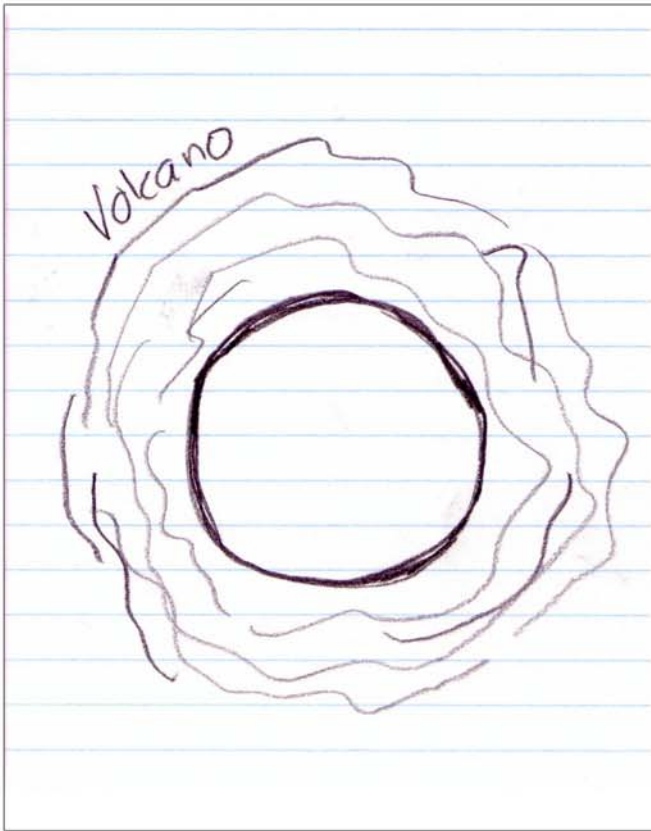

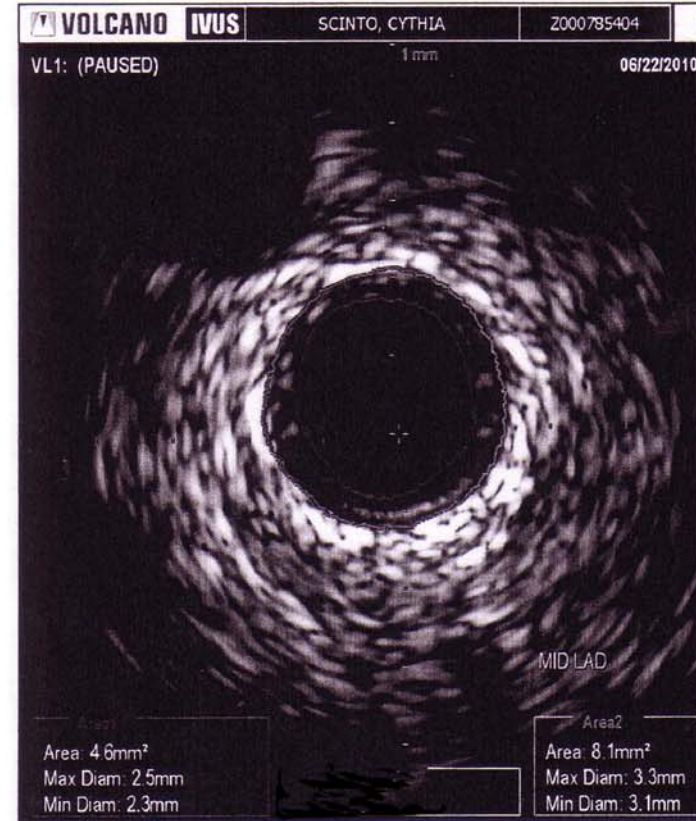


Two Days Later: Searching the Web for a picture of someone looking up through the bottom of a volcano seemed impossible. But I found this picture.

June 22, 2010: My five year anniversary of this heart transplant is July 14, 2010. Part of the annual exam is a heart catheterization. This year, the doctors did a special test to be able to see the most intricate details of the heart's coronary arteries.

Diabetics are not expected to do well and blockages are common at this point, making the life span of this heart shorter than most transplants. Living five years with the heart being fine is considered the best you can do.

The picture above is the result--PERFECT coronary arteries. Perfect! And as he put it, "You have five, ten or more healthy years to come with this heart."

Look at this picture--it is exactly what the Lord showed me three months ago. AND, the word VOLCANO is at the top left corner. The special machine that takes this picture is made by a company called, Volcano Incorporated.
